**Mandatory e-Payment of Service Tax by
 large tax payers: proposed interim accounting
 arrangement for e-Payment collection-**

With the introduction of mandatory e-payment of service tax for high value service tax payers, the need for eliminating the concept of designated banks for collection of tax through e-payment has risen. Central Board of Excise and Customs has in this regard prepared a detailed paper on Process and Accounting Procedure for Electronic Accounting Solution for receipts (EASer) and submitted it for approval. However, till EASer is approved and stabilized, the following interim accounting arrangement for e-payments shall be followed by your bank:

- (a) Your bank will be allowed to accept e-payments for all Central Excise and Service Tax commissionerates without the restriction of Commissionerate-wise authorization.
- (b) However, for physical collection of CBEC revenue, your bank will follow the existing restriction of commissionerates.
- (c) For all authorized commissionerates, your "existing Focal Point Branches" (FPB) will collate all physical payments and e-Payments for preparing the scroll. These FPB's will collate all physical payments and e-payments for preparing the scroll. These FPB's will act as receiving branch and FPB for e-payment collections. **The scrolling will be Commissionerate-wise and Major Head-wise**

Collection through e-payment mode for other Commissionerates that are not covered or physical collection will be collated at a branch in Delhi for scrolling (such CBS branch will be identified by your bank in consultation with CBEC and under advice to us). The branch so identified will prepare hard copies of Challan. The distribution and usage of stamped and receipted Challan will be as follows:

Challan Copy	To Whom	Purpose/Use
One	Concerned PAO(along with scroll)	Accounting and Reconciliation
Two	Taxpayer (At mailing address)	Tax return and record
One	Designated Divisional officer of the concerned commissionerate	Reconciliation with tax return.

(The scrolling will be commissionerate wise and major head)

- (e) Reporting to your link cell and fund settlement with RBI will be as per the existing procedure (Commissionerate-wise and Major Head-wise)
- (f) Proper mailing address of accounting authorities will be provided to your bank by CBEC authorities.
- (g) An online acknowledgement may also be given to the tax payer.
